About the Organization

The Chattanooga Design Studio is always looking for self-motivated, inspired, and team-oriented interns to join our efforts. As a steward of the city's rich legacy of urban design and planning, the Studio will strive to increase public awareness of urban design issues and our impact upon our quality of life. With a particular emphasis on the importance of the public realm, the Studio will provide high level coordination of urban design efforts to help frame a vision for the future growth of the city that promotes optimal value for the community.

About the Position

The Urban Design Intern will assist Design Studio staff with design and planning projects located within Chattanooga's dynamic downtown and Innovation District. Current projects respond to challenges in the urban environment, and include asset mapping, community engagement, redevelopment proposals, and streetscape studies.

You will contribute to the professional work of the Studio. Duties may include: preparing studies and visual materials in support of the design process; surveying and documenting field conditions and community preferences; and preparing for and participating in community meetings.

Qualifications

We value a variety of skills, with an emphasis on design process, critical thinking, research, drafting and rendering. The intern should bring some knowledge or interest in one or more of the following: Chattanooga; urban design; the public realm; and community development. The intern candidate should be prepared to work in a team setting and to work independently under the direction of the studio's professional staff.

Hours and Compensation

This is a part-time position, 15-20 hours per week, on site, during studio office hours - 8:30 am to 5:00 pm. These positions will generally be available from January 15 to May 15, 2018. Compensation will be \$10 per hour.
